

## **Effective October 21, 2020**

Effective **Wednesday, October 21**, By order of Governor Gavin Newsom, Riverside County slides back into more-restrictive **purple tier**.

Cafe Solaz will go back to **take-out only** and **outdoor dining**.

The Fitness center (GYM) will be **closed**.

Sports Complex and Pool remain open.

Congregating in the common area, with exception to outdoor dining is prohibited and facial coverings are required while moving through the common area. Facial covering must also be worn in the mailroom, **no exceptions**.

It is highly recommended to make an appointment with the Association office for any required services such as DRC applications, transponders and payment drop offs.

The county will remain in the purple tier for at least three weeks before it can move back to the red tier.

For those that have made reservations to utilize the fitness center at Trilogy this week, those reservations are cancelled until further notice. Our hope is to be able to re-open with a moment's notice when the mandates are lifted. Pools and courts will remain open, the previous rules apply.
